Reflection s for this week's readings

First Reading: Responsorial Psalm: Nehemiah 8: 2-6,8-10 Psalm 18 (19): 8-10,15

Second Reading:

1 Corinthians 12: 12-14,27)

Gospel:

Luke 1:1-4, 4: 14-21

As usual, the reading from Corinthians and Luke's Gospel complement each other perfectly. Paul's letter asserts that we are one body, each member supports the other. For instance, when writing a letter your arm reaches out to the paper, your hand holds and directs the pen, your eyes see what you are doing, and your brain thinks about what to write and coordinates the whole function by one team of various members: job done! - If any member fails to do his/her part, the intention to write the letter will have to be abandoned!

If one part of the body is hurting the entire body suffers, if not physically, at least psychologically. So is the position of each one of us as a part of one body of both our Church and humanity in general.

God blessed each one of us with certain talents and abilities not only for our own benefit but also to share with others. We all have a function or mission in this body to perform, not just for ourselves and our family. but also for the communities both close by and far away. After all we are all sons and daughters of One Father as we are members of one body. We cannot sit on the fence and opt out with any excuse when we see other people suffering, believing we are not our brother's keepers. We cannot leave all the work in our parish to be done by the usual few, but we must pull our weight, thus also the parish body will be whole and healthy.

Christ Himself, through our Baptism, handed to us His own Mission: to bring the good news to the poor in both material and spiritual needs: to release the captives from the bondage of stress, greed and any vice; to return sight to the blind who lost their way and are wasting their life solely on chasing material progress and high aspirations; and to assist in any way we can in restoring liberty to so many people, even whole nations oppressed by war, dictators and even institutionalised injustice.

So much is to be done! Where do I personally fit? Please Jesus, show me where and how I can lend a hand!
