

Faith as Key

IN MY LIFE, Faith is everything. That does not mean I have not strayed a few times in 81 years. My mother was my supreme example. She had no education and no professional skills except her unstinting faith. She cooked, cleaned, babysat, dressed corpses, wailed at funerals, and treated sprained legs and the like with traditional herbal medicines. With a little help from St Vincent de Paul, we all survived. Like most Goan families, the daily rosary and novena were paramount. She is no longer with us, but I am sure she is praying for us from up there with my two brothers and a sister.

My faith helped me get a job at the age of 12 (I was thin and tall and passed for someone much older) in a bank. Later I worked in the Civil Service and at 15 I became an instant sports journalist at first, and later climbed the highest rungs of the journalist ladder in Kenya, the UK and Australia.

Abraham was a man of supreme faith and God blessed him and made him the leader of His earthly flock. Abraham put his faith in the Lord, who credited him as an act of righteousness.

In my life, I have been blessed to meet and know many people of faith. Besides my mother, the greatest of these was the late Cardinal Maurice Otunga of Kenya. No airs, no graces, no pomp or ceremony, just pure human humility. In his presence, I felt something very holy, very special.

Look into your hearts, you will find faith there. If not pray to the Lord, especially at this time of Lent, when the impending death of Jesus Christ challenges us all.




Bishop Vincent presents at Australian Catholic Historical Society: 16 March
