### Reflections for this week's readings

First Reading: A Responsorial Psalm: Second Reading:

Acts 5: 27-32, 40-41 Psalm 29: 2, 4-6, 11-13 Revelations 5: 11-14

**Gospel:** John 21: 1-19

### Obey God before men.

We must obey God rather than men. Cast your mind just over the last few years: How many new trends were advocated and even enacted as law: like same-sex marriage, euthanasia, unchecked gambling, pornography, prostitution etc, all directly against God's Ten Commandments.

Should we meekly bow our head and go with the mob?

The reason to obey God before men is because God is not only most righteous and the source of all love, but also because He is wholly trustworthy and keeps His promises, as is clearly demonstrated by today's first reading and Gospel.

When the disciples faced the corrupt Council to justify their behaviour they replied: "We ought to obey God rather than men."

During this Year of the Jubilee of Hope it is particularly proper to reflect on today's Gospel regarding God's trustworthiness:

When Jesus suggested to cast the nets once more, logically His disciples did not see the point, but they eventually trusted Him and obeyed. We too often hesitate to obey when God, through our own conscience or on someone else's advice or example, commands or urges us to do a good deed. Sometimes we even completely ignore God's calling, perhaps doubting our capability, or because it may be too inconvenient or embarrassing.

We all strive to live a good life but, in this effort, we must not underestimate the importance of love. Jesus wanted to build His Church on earth trusting Peter as its leader. He did not ask him how rich or clever he was, nor which university he attended. No! His simple question was: Do you love me? Three times He asked to make sure before He entrusted him with His lambs and sheep.

So, does Jesus often asks us: Do you love me? If we sincerely reply: Yes! Then He goes on to instruct us to feed His lambs and sheep - and so we should, my friends, because it is not enough to talk the talk, but we must also walk the walk in order to arrive at the Gate behind which is everlasting pure love, rest and happiness for all of us who generously obey God's word during our short journey on earth.


