The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Reflections for this week's readings

First Reading: Genesis 14: 18-20 Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 109: 1-4

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 11: 23-26

Gospel: Luke 9: 11-17

Feast of Corpus Christi

St Juliana of Cornillon (1222–1258) had visions that inspired her deep love for the Eucharist. Because of her devotion, the Church established the Feast of Corpus Christi, which means "the Body of Christ." This feast, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, commemorates the belief that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist. The Catholic Church and many other Christian denominations celebrate it.

Karl Rahner, a Jesuit theologian, once said that this is a strange feast. That's because it celebrates something we already honour every day in church—the mystery of the altar. The Church holds a special procession to highlight what is received daily at Mass: the holy bread of eternal life. Each day, God prepares a sacred meal for us—the Lord's Supper. In 1545, the Council of Trent declared that the Blessed Sacrament should be carried through the streets to express our faith publicly.

Today's first reading tells us about Melchizedek, the king of Salem, who brought bread and wine as an offering. The Responsorial Psalm (Psalm 109) is a prophecy about the priesthood of Jesus, who is like Melchizedek. In the Gospel reading, Jesus broke bread and gave it to his disciples to share with the crowd. This reminds us of what happens at Mass every day: we celebrate a sacred meal where Jesus is received, his Passion is remembered, our souls are filled

with grace, and we are given a foretaste of the glory to come.


Young Adult Faith Formation: 6 July
