

"I ran a good race and fought a Good Fight'

Dear Sisters and Brothers, in this modern, fast-moving world, we often forget the Lord we serve and become engaged in worldly matters. The Feast of St. Peter and St. Paul reminds us that our dear Lord never takes His eyes off us.

St. Peter & St. Paul were often called the 2 Pillars of the Holy Catholic church and our faith. Peter was the rock upon whom the church was built, and Paul was the apostle to the Gentile's the non-believers, but what's interesting is that both men were sinful, both were weak, Fragile, and filled with so many human limitations. Peter was known as the denial king, and Paul the cruellest persecutor of the believers, but amid limitations and imperfections, they were called to spread the faith, and they strengthened the Christian community. This is the message on the solemnity of our lives.

This sacred day calls upon all of us to reflect on two towering pillars of faith, St. Peter and St. Paul, whose lives were marked not merely by their achievements but by their profound transformations. Their stories remind us that the

journey of faith is not about perfection; it is about resilience, repentance, and renewal. St. Peter, the fisherman who faltered under pressure yet rose to be the rock upon which the Church was built, and St. Paul, a former persecutor of Christians who became one of the faith's greatest champions, exemplify the boundless grace of God that transforms and uplifts.

One Important point I would like to share with you, my dear friends.

First, the feast of these wonderful followers of Christ reminds us that God can work through **Fragile**, **Weak**, **Sinful** people to establish his kingdom. My dear friends, allow God to show His strength in your weakness. Since we are weak, we are sinners, and we are not perfect, but the good news is like Peter and Paul, we are loved and chosen by God; admitting our limitations does not diminish our strength, my dear friends, I would like to invite you to use your weakness as a stepping stone to build and spread Gods kingdom here on earth never allow your weaknesses affects your greatness you are still great amidst of your imperfections.

The lives of these two men motivate me personally to focus and magnify on my strengths, not on my weaknesses, even when I fall, sin, and walk away from our lord at times, the catholic church, has a greatest gift of the sacrament of confession, which brings us back to Christ in Eucharist which I share with my 2 lovely Kids on our everyday challenges and I embrace teaching and share with them the goodness of our Lord Jesus on our lives.

Today's Gospel invites us with Deeper questions from our Lord Jesus: Who do you think I am in your lives today? I pray that every one of us has the same courage as Peter had to respond to Jesus, Lord, you are my Personal Saviour and my Master.
