## Reflections for this week's readings

**First Reading:** Malachi 3: 19-20 **Responsorial Psalm:** Psalm 97: 5-9

**Second Reading:** 2 Thessalonians 3: 7-12

Gospel: Luke 21: 5-19

This week's gospel from Luke describes Jesus' prophecy about the destruction of the Jerusalem temple & the signs of the end times, warning against deception & panic while urging followers to stand firm in their faith during persecution.

It includes warnings that worldly structures & institutions are temporary, however, true faith in God provides the endurance needed to overcome persecution, by holding onto our faith, we will be spiritually redeemed.

It is also a reminder as followers to not be misled by false prophets or those who falsely claim to be the Messiah.

Events like wars, uprisings, famines & natural disasters will occur but are not immediate signs of the end itself. Whilst these difficult times are inevitable, God's presence provides hope & strength. We will eventually gain eternal life through steadfast faith, not by avoiding suffering. I remember Fr Bernard saying once that God does not burden us with things beyond what we can endure. This is especially relevant in these current times where our faith can be constantly tested.

In times of persecution Jesus assures us we will be given the wisdom to defend ourselves.

The core message of this passage is a call to endurance, to not panic, to hold firm in our faith. To focus on God & eternal life rather than becoming too fixated on temporary human institutions that will eventually be destroyed.


