Reflections for this week's readings

First Reading: Isaiah 2:1-5

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 121: 1-2, 4-5, 6-9 **Second Reading:** Romans 13:11-14

Gospel: Matthew 24:37-44

The start of Advent begins a period of hope, preparation and anticipation. Of these themes, hope is particularly apparent throughout the four weeks of Advent.

This week, we are encouraged to be hopeful, and to believe darkness will not prevail, the light of the world overcoming this darkness. We are urged to be alert and ready.

Being disciples requires vigilance, attention and a readiness to act at any moment. This does not suggest we should live in fear; rather we should live with purpose. We should be attentive to the presence of Christ in our daily lives.

Perhaps to put this into action, we could pray to be better able to recognise the Lord's face when He appears in our lives, especially in the interruptions and frustrations that may throw us off balance.

Celebrating Advent at Home

An easy way to continue our community's celebration of Advent in your own home is to prepare an Advent wreath. You may wish to make your own, or purchase a wreath set from a local store - Church Stores (in Wenty), the St Patrick's Cathedral Gift Shop and CMP Religious Store in Granville are all nearby.

The Church's Book of Blessings provides a prayer for you to bless wreath home. your at olmcwentyliturgy.org/wreath for an outline of this short ritual that you can download or use on a device such as a phone or tablet, as well as supporting material for each week.

Lighting the candles of the wreath can be a part of a family's prayer before an evening meal during Advent. When lighting the first candle this week, pray the Collect Prayer for today's Mass, which is provided below:

Let us pray.

Grant your faithful, we pray, almighty God, the resolve to run forth to meet your Christ with righteous deeds at his coming, so that, gathered at his right hand, they may be worthy to possess the heavenly Kingdom.
