



Reflections for this week's readings

First Reading: Isaiah 8:23 – 9:3
Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 26:1, 4, 13 - 14
Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 1:10 – 13, 17
Gospel: Matthew 4:12 – 23

"I will make you fishers of men"

The prophet Isaiah announced a future of liberation and great joy for all of Galilee, through the image of light that dispels the darkness in which the people walk. The Gospel, quoting verbatim the same passage of the prophet Isaiah, presents Jesus as the Light, thus fulfilling Isaiah's prophecy. He is the light that was promised to dispel the darkness of sin and to free people from the obscurity in which they enclosed.

In today's Gospel, we hear about the call of the first four disciples of Jesus - Peter, Andrew, James and John. He invites these four fishermen, saying, "Follow me and I will make you fishers of people." It can be noted that all four of them immediately abandon their nets and boats, as well as their family, to follow Jesus. They don't wait or ask any questions. They do not know the consequences of their quick decision. Yet what we find in their spontaneous response is the total abandonment and wholehearted commitment to Jesus and His call.

This Sunday's Gospel invites us to remember that our personal vocation is founded on God's original and free choice. His invitation towards us, therefore, is an invitation to make a final decision to let Him conquer or re-conquer us to mark a turning point in our lives.

Let us ask the Lord, for us and the whole Church and us, for the gift of a true conversion of our hearts, enabling us

to receive Christ as the only Light to follow. Christ is the only one who really dispels the darkness within and around us.
